

Featured Speaker: Steve Fransen, WSU-Prosser

Steve was the Forage Specialist at Puyallup for many years before moving to his current position in Prosser. He has done forage work on both sides of the Cascades and has a good handle on forage management and plant growth.

Steve's first talk will talk about grass management with a focus on the roots and what they can tell us. His second talk will focus on producing high quality grass balage. His interactive presentations are very educational and enjoyable, with good audience participation.
